




The journey goes on

In Paraguay, we live very close to one of the natural wonders of the world: Iguazú Falls. And beyond that, there is another wonder—this one from modern engineering and a powerful example of cooperation between Paraguay and Brazil: the Itaipú Dam. It is one of the world's greatest producers of clean, renewable energy, with an installed capacity of 14,000 MW, distributed across 20 turbines of 700 MW each.

Both of these wonders point us to the creative power of God, displayed through the mighty river system of this region—the Paraná River basin. That leads us to a meaningful metaphor: when water flows in a well-directed channel, it generates useful energy; and when a believer's life is truly connected to our Lord Jesus and properly aligned, it produces fruit, consistency, and service.

That's what missionary work is all about—using everything God has provided and channeling it wisely so it becomes a blessing to the people we serve (Romans 12:1–2; 2 Timothy 2:1–2; 3:16–17), and being faithful ambassadors of the message of salvation in our Lord Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 5:20).

What's been going on?

Over these past months, we've worked hard to give the Lord our very best—using the gifts and abilities He has given us. Little by little, we've been building relationships with local people and giving them a better opportunity to truly get to know us. Of course, we've made mistakes along the way, but we've also made progress, and people are beginning to see our hearts.

Also we have completed a set of material used to teach believers the basic doctrines of the faith, as well as some convictions that distinguish us from other churches. Our goal is to help people better understand the message for our time that we find in Scripture—especially in the teachings of the apostle Paul. One of our goals is for this material to be useful not only here, but also for other fields across Latin America.

Also, one of our goals is to begin in early 2026 to train local leaders more intentionally as a team, using several tools God has placed within our reach—the Bible Institute, solid reference-book studies, and above all, an ongoing mentoring process with them. Please pray for this objective (2 Timothy 2:2).

In addition, we are continuing to work on our devotional series on the life of the apostle Paul, as well as a new children's resource focused on God's plan.

Finally, something very important: as a team, we are developing a strategic plan to expand into new areas, including the community of La Blanca and other nearby communities. Please pray for this goal as well.
